Adult Ministries Associate - Women's Ministry

Purpose

The mission of Christ Community Church's Women's Ministry is to connect women to life-defining relationships in Christ.

Position Description

This part-time Adult Ministries Associate role requires working a monthly schedule of hours in the range of 25-30 hours per month in providing ministry support as follows:

- Ministry Team: Provide oversight and vision development for the Women's Ministry Team in cooperation with the Pastor of Discipleship. Attend the weekly church staff team meeting and monthly adult ministry team meetings. Coordinate communication about women's ministry between the team, church staff, and the church.
- Women's Ministry Programs: Coordinate and give direction to women's Bible study, learning, and connecting
 opportunities with the adult ministry team. Develop connection points from women's ministry programming
 into the church's Gather, Connect, Serve strategy and follow up with those who express interest in women's
 ministry programs, events, etc.
- **Special Events**: Provide leadership and support to the women's ministry team as they plan conferences and retreats that are congruent with a charge to connect women in life-defining relationships in Christ.

Reporting/Coaching responsibility

This person reports to and is coached by the Pastor of Discipleship

Qualifications, skills, and gifts

- A sincere and growing personal commitment to Jesus Christ, including:
 - Consistent moral and ethical integrity in regard to work and relationships
 - Familiarity with the Bible and appreciation for its authority
- Positive communication and interpersonal skills
- Diligence and thoroughness in organizational and administrative tasks
- Discernment and leadership when dealing with conflict resolution and ministry direction.
- An appreciation and enjoyment of women and their variety of roles in life with a desire to encourage, empower, and equip women to use their unique gifts.
- Ability to recruit and organize teams of volunteers to carry out the work of the ministry
- Teachable, servant-hearted and flexible. Continually developing her gifts and knowledge through training, networking, and personal development.

Other Considerations

The church will provide the use of an office for services performed on the church campus and for preparation related to those services.

The church will provide support staff services for the ministry programs listed above.

Christ Community Church *Ames Iowa EFCA Statement of Faith

God

1. We believe in one God, Creator of all things, holy, infinitely perfect, and eternally existing in a loving unity of three equally divine Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Having limitless knowledge and sovereign power, God has graciously purposed from eternity to redeem a people for Himself and to make all things new for His own glory.

The Bible

2. We believe that God has spoken in the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, through the words of human authors. As the verbally inspired Word of God, the Bible is without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for salvation, and the ultimate authority by which every realm of human knowledge and endeavor should be judged. Therefore, it is to be believed in all that it teaches, obeyed in all that it requires, and trusted in all that it promises.

The Human Condition

3. We believe that God created Adam and Eve in His image, but they sinned when tempted by Satan. In union with Adam, human beings are sinners by nature and by choice, alienated from God, and under His wrath. Only through God's saving work in Jesus Christ can we be rescued, reconciled and renewed.

Jesus Christ

4. We believe that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, fully God and fully man, one Person in two natures. Jesus—Israel's promised Messiah—was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He lived a sinless life, was crucified under Pontius Pilate, arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father as our High Priest and Advocate.

The Work of Christ

5. We believe that Jesus Christ, as our representative and substitute, shed His blood on the cross as the perfect, all-sufficient sacrifice for our sins. His atoning death and victorious resurrection constitute the only ground for salvation.

The Holy Spirit

6. We believe that the Holy Spirit, in all that He does, glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ. He convicts the world of its guilt. He regenerates sinners, and in Him they are baptized into union with Christ and adopted as heirs in the family of God. He also indwells, illuminates, guides, equips and empowers believers for Christ-like living and service.

The Church

7. We believe that the true church comprises all who have been justified by God's grace through faith alone in Christ alone. They are united by the Holy Spirit in the body of Christ, of which He is the Head. The true church is manifest in local churches, whose membership should be composed only of believers. The Lord Jesus mandated two ordinances, baptism and the Lord's Supper, which visibly and tangibly express the gospel. Though they are not the means of salvation, when celebrated by the church in genuine faith, these ordinances confirm and nourish the believer.

Christian Living

8. We believe that God's justifying grace must not be separated from His sanctifying power and purpose. God commands us to love Him supremely and others sacrificially, and to live out our faith with care for one another, compassion toward the poor and justice for the oppressed. With God's Word, the Spirit's power, and fervent prayer in Christ's name, we are to combat the spiritual forces of evil. In obedience to Christ's commission, we are to make disciples among all people, always bearing witness to the gospel in word and deed.

Christ's Return

9. We believe in the personal, bodily and premillennial return of our Lord Jesus Christ. The coming of Christ, at a time known only to God, demands constant expectancy and, as our blessed hope, motivates the believer to godly living, sacrificial service and energetic mission.

Response and Eternal Destiny

10. We believe that God commands everyone everywhere to believe the gospel by turning to Him in repentance and receiving the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe that God will raise the dead bodily and judge the world, assigning the unbeliever to condemnation and eternal conscious punishment and the believer to eternal blessedness and joy with the Lord in the new heaven and the new earth, to the praise of His glorious grace.
