A LOOK IN GOD'S WORD (some key ideas about Jesus and the Spirit)

Jesus and the Spirit: Was conceived by a miraculous work of the Spirit (Mt.1:18) Jesus was full of the Spirit and led by the Spirit (Lk. 4)

My life and the Spirit: God equips his children through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit works in us to change and sanctify us. (1Peter1:2) The Holy Spirit produces in us the fruit of the Spirit (Gal5:22). As we grow we "walk by the Spirit" and are "led by the Spirit" (Gal.5:16-18)

BEGIN WITH YOUR HEART

Review: What were the 6 Foundational Priorities of Jesus?

A LOOK IN GOD'S WORD

Consider the following passages and discuss as a group: What do they teach us about Jesus?

Jesus' humanity on display in the desert:

- Heb. 2:17-18 "¹⁷ Therefore he had to be <u>made like his brothers</u> in <u>every respect</u>, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. ¹⁸ For because <u>he himself has suffered when tempted</u>, he is able to help those who are being tempted."
- **Heb 4:15** "¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who **in every respect has been tempted as we are**, yet without sin."
- **Phil. 2:6-8** 6"... who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but <u>emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant</u>, being born in the likeness of men. 8 And <u>being found in human form</u>, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

Going back to Luke 4:1-13, do you see agreement with the passages above and the person of Jesus? le. Does the humanity of Jesus in the desert match the humanity of Jesus in the passages above?

- If yes, where / how?
- If no, why? What do you disagree with?

In the light of Luke 4 & the passages above, what was the role of the Holy Spirit in the life and ministry of Jesus, particularly in the desert?

What is the role of the Holy Spirit in my life and ministry today? What are the implications of my answer to that question?

YOUR FAMILY – At a dinner table this week, review the 6 LIFE QUESTIONS. Explore with your family members their understanding of what each question means. Which question(s) resonate best with you...and your kids? Do you think it might help to discuss these together as a family each week?

OUR MISSION – Our LIFE QUESTIONS help us assess if our every-day walk with God is engaging in our church's mission. The more regular our meeting with God, the more we ask for the Spirit's flowing presence, the more we share our tough stuff with spiritual accountability partners, the more we "put out the welcome mat" to people not yet in God's family...well, the more the Lord *connects people to life-defining relationships in Christ*. Right? Let's lean into our Father's provisions, and these great questions, together!!
