CONNECT GROUP QUESTIONS INTENTIONAL: The Values of our FAMILY

INTRO: This week's teaching introduced us to the INTENTIONALITY of God's family [the CCC Body of Christ] understanding and expressing 4 key "family values."

QUESTIONS: What are the 4 CCC ministry [and family] values?

Why are they important to the mission God has given us?

Begin with Your EXPERIENCE

Begin by thinking about the family you grew up in, or the family that you have raised. **IDENTIFY and SHARE what you consider to be 2 of your family's values.** Name the value [e.g., HONESTY, HARD WORK] and then write a statement which briefly explains how that "value" was to be understood.

Look in the WORD

TRANSPARENT RELATIONSHIPS: creating a culture of humility, acceptance and grace
INTER-GENERATIONAL DISCIPLESHIP: investing in each other's lives across multiple generations
PURPOSEFUL RESPONSIVENESS: seeking and seizing the opportunities God provides each day
RADICAL GENEROSITY: living adventurously to impact our world
