A LOOK IN GOD'S WORD

What was the initial response to Jesus' resurrection? This is a very intriguing study about how the different groups of people responded to the resurrection. I'm not sure I've ever looked at all of these passages together, side by side. Read the passages together and jot down your observations. There are some simple application ideas that follow – pick at least one application step if you can't get to them all.

MY LIFE- OUR MISSION

It matters. The fact that Jesus rose from the dead changes everything. When you place your faith in Him and your hope in His resurrection, your life is now defined in Christ and you have a new mission to share that good news with others. A side discussion to this portion of the study may be to talk about what makes us apprehensive about sharing this good news with people we know and love. We often want them to know it, it means everything to us, but we can be apprehensive to bring it up. Explore why that is.

Connect Group Study for RADICAL #6

Radically Victorious: The Resurrection of the Savior

This week's teaching focused on two key questions: *Is Jesus the crucified Christ actually alive?* And *If so, so what?* As you know, there were different responses to the resurrection of Jesus. Belief, doubt, denial, wonder, anger.

BEGIN WITH YOUR HEART

Take some minutes and share with your group what the resurrection of Jesus the crucified Christ means to you. **What significance does it have for your life?** Does it give you hope? Because of the resurrection of Jesus, what are you hoping for? What are you confident it? Invest some important moments in sharing.

IN THE WORD

Let's explore the different reactions to the report of Jesus' bodily resurrection. Read the passages; describe in your words the reaction.

Mark 16:9-13

Luke 24:1-12

Luke 24:13-35

John 20:24-28
(cf. 1 Peter 1:8-9)

Paul catalogues Jesus' resurrection appearances in 1 Corinthians 15:3-9 (READ). How important is it that we believe that Jesus actually came back from death, and rose from the grave bodily? (see 1 Corinthians 15:12-23). Explain this in your own words to your group – how would you say what Paul is saying about the importance of the resurrection.

MY LIFE, OUR MISSION

Our mission is about a RISEN, LIVING savior. *Connect people to life-defining relationships IN CHRIST.* It is through our "in-Christ" relationships that our very thinking and living can be *redefined*. We offer the very life of the living Christ to one another and those who are outside the family of God.

So what would you say should someone ask, "Do you REALLY think Jesus Christ rose from the dead? Why?" Could you give a clear, helpful answer? [practice with your group members]

Spend some time praying for those you know who may be doubting or dismissing the truth of the resurrection of Jesus. Ask God in PRAYER how you can CARE for them so that, at the right moment, you can SHARE with them that Jesus is truly alive, and that real, eternal life can be found in Him. His resurrection means everything!
